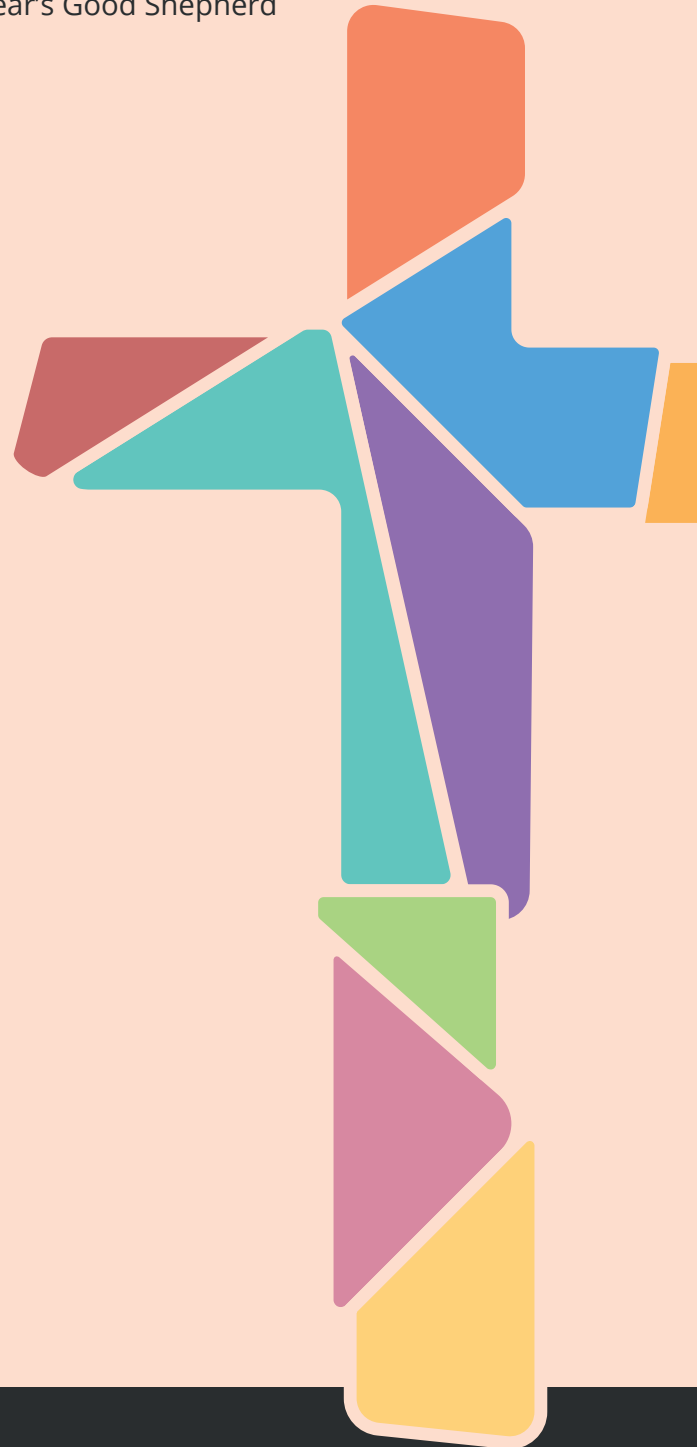


#GSChallenge
